



# East Coast Express. 20th – 24th October 2010.

## Day 1. 20th October. Auckland – Napier.

**D**epart Auckland at 8am by coach through Auckland's southern suburbs, over the Bombay Hills following the Waikato River through the coal mining region of Huntly. Then on through the rich Cambridge farmland with its many stud farms.

Before our lunch stop in Taupo we will make a stop at the Huka Falls and then in the afternoon travel across the stark beauty of the Rangataiki plains before the crossing the spectacular Huiarua Range to the East Coast and the Art Deco city of Napier.

## Day 2. 21st of October. Napier to Gisborne by steam train.



This morning we join Mainline Steam at Napier and travel behind their beautifully restored steam locomotive J1211 as we travel to Wairoa and then alongside the spectacular coastline, sometimes at sea level and sometimes high above the water. Looking out to sea from high on the cliffs at Beach Loop you can see the curvature of the earth. Mainline

Steam has photo runs along the way giving you the chance to get off the train and take photos as it thunders past the photo line.

**Day 3. 22nd of October.**  
**Gisborne to Napier by steam train.**

This morning early risers can be the first in the country to see the sunrise on a new day. Then we rejoin Mainline Steam for the return journey to Napier giving you a chance to take in the sights you may have missed yesterday.

**Day 4. 23rd of October.**  
**Napier.**



This morning we will take in the local sights of this beautiful Art Deco city and visit the famous Mission Vineyard where you will have the opportunity to try some of their product before heading back into town where you have the afternoon free to explore at your leisure.

**Day 5. 24th of October.**  
Today we are homeward bound with a late afternoon arrival in Auckland.
